A Christian Ministry in the National Parks Advanced Leadership Development Program (ALDP)



12-16 individuals will be selected to participate in an intensive leadership development program unique to A Christian Ministry in the National Parks (ACMNP). This program

was originally designed for seminary and graduate students but has been expanded to include exceptional undergraduates and non-students. ALDP participants will focus on the practical exploration and development of their Christian leadership capacities as identified through the Lion's Lead Leadership Assessment, spearhead a ministry project in their assigned park, assist with the ACMNP National Training Conference, and invest effort in significant reflection throughout their season. Participants will receive a \$1,000 scholarship, training, and support from ACMNP National Staff, Ministry Support Committee, and mentor where available.

Application Process

- 1. Apply to ACMNP's ministry program online at www.acmnp.com/apply-now/.

 ACMNP assumes that you will be involved in the ministry program even if you are not chosen to participate in the ALDP. You may be offered a summer placement before the ALDP participants are chosen.
- 2. After completing your ACMNP application, send an email to ddegler@acmnp.com indicating that you intend to apply for the Advanced Leadership Development Program. Dave will send you an application. You may be contacted for a phone interview after receiving your ALDP application.
- 3. Your ALDP application must be received on or before Wednesday, March 16. Before is preferred.
- 4. Final decisions on participants in this program will be made on or before Friday, March 18.

Program Details - Please read carefully.

- 1. You must be available to participate in the ALDP Training event on **April 20-22** in Estes Park, CO. Exceptions are not made.
- 2. You must attend the ACMNP National Training Conference from April 20-24.
- 3. You are responsible for the \$350 ACMNP Program Fee (ACMNP alum \$275). This fee includes the ALDP training, assessment, the National Training Conference, a post-season debrief, ministry materials, summer staff visit, and much more.
- 4. You must take the LeadRight Leadership Assessment through Sunday, **April 10**. The assessment, valued at \$400, will be paid for by ACMNP.
- 5. You will be trained to interpret the Successful Student Profile assessments that are given to all ACMNP Ministry Team Members.
- 6. You will lead an ACMNP Ministry Team.
- 7. You will work a full time job in the park as part of the ACMNP ministry experience.
- 8. You will complete a significant and personalized ministry project in the park with training, assistance, and support from the National Office.
- 9. You will participate in an end-of-season questionnaire and a end-of-year online debrief.
- 10. You will receive a \$1,000 scholarship upon completion of your commitments to ACMNP and your employer.
