Responsibilities

- Interact with NPS, park concessionaires, and other groups serving Grand Canyon NP to build bridges and foster collaborative efforts, pursuing opportunities to share God's love, grace, and acceptance within the park community.
- Instigate and lead Bible studies and affinity groups in service to the community and mission of the church.
- Mentor, encourage, and support ACMNP seasonal ministry team members.
- Partner with ACMNP leadership to coordinate ministry programs in the park.
- Engage with residents, staff, and visitors in a spirit of hospitality and witness.
- Work alongside church leadership to guide vision, outreach, and discipleship.
